CLERK: Mr. President, inasmuch...Senator Chambers, your amendments were to that amendment, so I'm going to assume you want to pass those over, Senator, and do them on Select File likewise?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: That is correct. Thank you.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We're back to discussion of LB 994. The question...anybody wishing to discuss advancement? Senator...or, Chairman of the committee, Health and Human Services Committee, Senator, did you waive closing? Senator Jensen waives closing. The question before the body is, shall LB 994 advance to E & R Initial? All in favor of the motion vote aye; opposed, nay. We're voting on advancement of LB 994. CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 mays on the advancement of LB 994, Mr. President.
