CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

The two amendments I have supported. I think it's good legislation. So I ask for your support. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Janssen. You've heard the closing on LB 562. The question before the body is, shall LB 562 advance to E & R Initial? All in favor vote aye; opposed, nay. The question before the body is advancement of LB 562, E & R Initial. Have you all voted on the question who care to? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 562.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 562 does advance. Mr. Clerk, items for the record, or messages?

CLERK: Thank you, Mr. President. Your Committee on Education reports LB 1208 to General File with amendments. That's offered by Senator Raikes, as Chair. Senator Price, new A bill.
