CLERK: Senator Chambers would move to amend with FA537.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, to open.

Mr. President, members of the Legislature, Senator Schrock pointed out, I want to simply change the word "less," where it appears in several places, to the word "fewer," because we're talking about a number of objects. Senator Schrock said he agrees with the amendment. That's what it is. I will answer any questions, but that is all I think I need to say at this time. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. You've heard the opening on the Chambers amendment. For discussion, Senator Schrock.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes. Thank you, Mr. President. And, Senator Chambers, we do agree to this. It does read better, and we thank you for your amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Further discussion on the Chambers amendment? Further discussion? There are no lights on. Senator Chambers, did you wish to close? Senator Chambers waives closing. The question before the body is adoption of amendment FA537, offered by Senator Chambers to FA485. All in favor vote aye; opposed, nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.
