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LB 248, 252, 829

maybe, Senator Baker, I just want to clarify, if you would yield?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Baker, would you yield?

SENATOR BAKER: Yes, I would.

SENATOR THOMPSON: So LB 829, is that the basis of the argument here?

SENATOR BAKER: Yes, that's the original bill.

SENATOR THOMPSON: That's the original bill. Was that bill...

SENATOR BAKER: No, I'm sorry, that wasn't either the bill. It was a bill last year, so it couldn't have been LB 829. It was LB 252, my counsel is telling me.

SENATOR THOMPSON: LB 252?

SENATOR BAKER: LB 252.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Okay, so it's last...okay. That helps.

SENATOR BAKER: This issue has been around a long time.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Right. I understand. I'm just trying to sort this out in the process here. I'm not from Omaha. I'm not on the Transportation Committee. I'm not on the Revenue Committee. So I'm just trying to get squared up. So the bill that this...so tell me the bill number again?

SENATOR BAKER: LB 252.

SENATOR THOMPSON: LB 252, and that was voted out of...

SENATOR BAKER: We're checking on it right now. I think we've got it confirmed it was LB 252, but I don't know.
