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a reappointment?

SENATOR BAKER: That's correct.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: How many times...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: And you may continue. Your light is next.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President. That is very generous and I appreciate it. Senator Baker, how many times prior to this reappointment had Mr. Acklie been reappointed, if such a thing has occurred?

SENATOR BAKER: I do not see that on his application, Senator Chambers. I don't know. I'd have to get that from someone, I suppose, on that board.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Did he ask to be reappointed, do you know? Or was he solicited?

SENATOR BAKER: I don't know. I can't answer that question. I don't know.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Do you have a copy of his application form?

SENATOR BAKER: Yes, I do.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Is there a place on that form for an individual to check his or her political affiliation?

SENATOR BAKER: Yes, there is.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Did Mr. Acklie check his political affiliation?

SENATOR BAKER: Yes.
