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SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mention was made specifically of a runway. Are you familiar with or aware that a runway was a part of the development or redevelopment or renovation of this airport facility?

SENATOR MINES: I am aware.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Is there anything unique about this runway which would cause you to recognize it if you flew 500 feet above that runway, 500 feet above ten other runways? Is there something about this one that would stick out in your mind, and if it were possible to remove it from Blair so you wouldn't know from the geographical location?

SENATOR MINES: That was my answer. It's in Washington County. That's what makes it unique.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. Other than its being located in Washington County, are you aware of anything unique about it?

SENATOR MINES: Not from a technical standpoint, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: If somebody told you that an individual designed that runway...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Further discussion? Senator Thompson, followed by Senator Chambers.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Senator Chambers, would you yield to a question?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, would you yield?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: With great fear and trepidation.
