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Baker, I believe that the appointment was in line.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And I voted for him too. Are you going to vote for Ms. Barbara Keegan?

SENATOR MINES: I am, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Are you going to vote for all of the nominees?

SENATOR MINES: I trust that the committee did their work, yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: If the committee did not do its work, then we could be misled, as happened with a DEQ appointment...

SENATOR MINES: Absolutely.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...maybe last session?

SENATOR MINES: Absolutely.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But that is not a regular occurrence that we have discovered to be the case.

SENATOR MINES: That's true.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Senator Mines. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I am going to vote for this appointee. I probably will vote for the others, but I enjoy having Senator Baker give us information about these individuals.

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And had we not had our exchange...did you say one minute?

SENATOR CUDABACK: I did, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...we would not have known that Ms. Keegan drove 500 or so miles to appear and speak. That does show to me
