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SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Baker, had you seen Mr. Lux prior to his appearance before your committee on the date that he was testifying?

SENATOR BAKER: Yes. I'd have to check back. I've been on that committee a number of years so this is a reappointment, they're four-year terms, so I'm assuming either I...I'm assuming I said he was before the committee originally because this...the last...this is his first reappointment. So I'm guessing he was in front of the committee four years prior to this because it would have been his initial appearance before the committee.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Baker, who spoke during this process on his behalf?

SENATOR BAKER: He appeared in person and also Larry Dix from Nebraska Association of County Officials spoke on his behalf, for him.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Now, yes, Mr. Dix spoke for Ms. Keegan, but he didn't have much to say other than that you should support her nomination. What did he have to say, if you remember, about Mr. Lux?

SENATOR BAKER: I believe he mentioned the fact that Mr. Lux had been a county board member for a long time. And I believe, looking at his information here, he's been on Dodge County Board, I don't know whether it's commissioners or supervisors, he's been on there since 1977. I remember asking a question about term limits, and he thought maybe he'd be in favor of term limits on the county board position. That would be 29 years he's been on that county board. And...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And he said he might favor term limits for county board members?

SENATOR BAKER: (Laugh) We asked him that...I recall asking that question.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And he said he might favor that for a county
