SENATOR STUTHMAN: On my...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: On your scale.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: On my scale of 1 to 10, about 5.1.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: 5.1. So "plunderer" would not have a chance.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: No, not really. I would think...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Taker-to-the-cleaners, hyphenated; taker-to-the-cleaners; would that be...what...where will that be on your scale?

SENATOR STUTHMAN: That'd be about a 5.01. That wouldn't work either.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Getting close?

SENATOR STUTHMAN: It would be getting a little bit closer, but not close enough by a long way.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And you won't support this amendment that's pending now.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the closing on FA334, offered by Senator Chambers to LB 542. The question before the body is, shall that amendment be adopted? All in favor vote aye; opposed, nay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, I will ask for a call of the house.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Been a request for a call of the house. All in favor of the house going under call vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.
