SENATOR BURLING: I believe that's right.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. And this amendment is properly drafted to that amendment. It's on the gadget now. On page 2, in line 19, I would strike the word "nearby." Then, in line 20, I would insert the words, after the word "states," "having demographics similar to those of Nebraska." I don't know whether at some point Senator Schimek will be able to take a look at this. She doesn't need to right now. But I would ask her to consider it. I'm going to ask Senator Burling a question, though, Mr. Speaker, if he will yield again.

SENATOR BURLING: Yeah. Oh.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Burling, will you hold one second so I can be sure that we're coordinated here?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I'm going to pull that amendment that would have been up in this order because it also was drafted to the prior amendment, which would make it inappropriate at this point.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Senator Burling, now I'm back to this amendment...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Clerk.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh, excuse me.

SENATOR CUDABACK: One second, Mr. Clerk...or, Senator Chambers. Mr. Clerk first.
