and embryos. You know why they pretend to care? Because an embryo doesn't get hungry. You don't have to talk about feeding You know what the Catholic Church and others hungry embryos. have done? They have gotten the Bush administration to withhold money that had ordinarily gone as humanitarian aids to countries because those countries practice or allow or encourage birth But you know what I don't hear all of these Holy Joes doing? Jumping on their hobbyhorse when they can see 10,000 children in Africa dying from starvation, tens of thousands dying a year from curable, treatable diseases. They don't care about children. But if one of those black women talks about having an abortion, or one of those countries has enlightened policy of giving sex education which includes birth control, then they jump on their hobbyhorse and they beat their gums about how wrong that is. But they are watching children starve and die from diseases that are treatable. Why, if all these religions...and now I'm not just talking about the Catholics; they're just out there in front. If all of these hypocritical religions, who talk all of this concern they have about birth control being taught, would rally their forces to say, we're going to get food to these children dying of starvation, constantly ill due to malnutrition, dying from diseases that don't even exist anymore in the so-called first and second world, then inroads could be made with reference to those problems of starving children and diseased children. they could be converted once again to fetuses, embryos, and zygotes and allowed to reenter their mother's womb, then you'd see these Catholics, these Baptists, these Methodists, these Episcopalians, and all the rest of the hypocrites showing great concern for fear that the woman might have an abortion. don't care about these children, and they demonstrate it. And that's why I get so exercised when these kind of hypocritical bills come before us, then people like Senator Foley stand on the floor and say, well, a prosecutor is not going to bring this prosecution. They're not interested in the prosecution; they're interested in making a political statement, and they're interested in hounding and harassing women. That's what it is.
