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They're insecure around women. And that's why the sex between them and a woman is not based on love, affection, and those tender feelings, but power: I have the sperm and you are the receptacle, and I will inject that sperm into you as a receptacle, and you will bear these babies and demonstrate that I'm a man because I can make babies just like a jackass can make babies, if a jackass can make babies. Is a jackass able to make babies? Then let's let the jackass go, and say a stallion. Making babies makes you a man?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: It makes a male. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Further discussion? Senator Schimek, followed by Senators Engel, Johnson, Foley, and Chambers. Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Mr. President and members. certainly glad I get to follow you, Senator Chambers. (Laugh) I haven't voted yes or no on this bill. On General File, I was a "pot voting." I understand the impetus for bringing the bill. I understand, I think, at least some of the motivation for bringing the bill, and I think some of the motivation is good. I don't think anybody--certainly, I don't--I don't think anybody probably in this room, as Senator Johnson noted, wants to see a woman lose a child who has been anxiously awaited and who is wanted very badly. I don't attribute that to anybody. And I don't doubt, Senator Foley, the study that you read. I think it's very true that oftentimes women, for one reason or another, are in a situation in which maybe there isn't a real healthy relationship, and because she's pregnant, the partner will take it out on her because she got pregnant. So I don't doubt that at all. I have difficulty in imagining penalties being imposed a woman who might be so newly pregnant...or, not on the woman, but on the perpetrator against the woman, who may be so newly pregnant that maybe only her immediate family knows she's pregnant. I don't know how, and you've answered this to some degree, how a prosecutor prosecutes when there really isn't a body, as Senator Chambers said so many times on General File. I think it's difficult. So I want to address this from the point
