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the question, then, that I want to talk about this time, is this: What is this unborn child? And is it the fertilized egg, that you've been calling a child and what Senator Chambers calls a zygote? Now, if this is a unanimous or a common definition, then I've got to ask you this; that if we have this egg, and a researcher then comes along and does research on that egg...it's never been in the uterus, so we can't call it a pregnancy, but we are calling it by, as I understand it, your definition, an unborn child. So if a research person then comes along and does research on that egg, is the researcher then guilty of injuring an unborn child, or perhaps even killing the child, by this definition? And along that line, there are fertility clinics that have...when these are used to try and successfully complete a pregnancy, many of these are used at one time, and so again, if you had a situation where not all of these implants were used, and you threw out the other ones, did you commit a crime against those? The other one that I can think of like that would be dispensing a morning after pill, the so-called plan B, to a person that thinks she could become pregnant. We don't know that, she just had the possibility, and then she didn't become pregnant. Would the person that dispensed the medications be, you know, a candidate for a charge of murder or great bodily injury or whatever to a single cell? And where I'm getting at, I guess, basically, is this; is that, with your bill, does this mean that you would stop stem cell research in this state? When it comes down to it, that is really one of my main concerns, is that is this a backdoor way of stopping stem cell research in this state? I'll yield you the rest of my time, and we'll go from there.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Foley, about one minute.

SENATOR FOLEY: Again, Senator Johnson, thank you very much, both for the time and for the question. You've asked another very good question and it merits a proper response. I would direct you to the green copy of the bill, if you have one available, and look at lines 8, 9, and 10 on page 2, because that's really the core of my...I'll just read it to you. "For purposes of the Assault of an Unborn Child Act, unborn child means an individual member of the species Homo sapiens at any stage of development," and here's the key words, "in utero,"
