SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...and I also let them know, when I talk to you, you're not going to hear me tell you, you ain't no good, you ain't going to amount to nothing. I said, you got plenty of people doing that for you. The preacher will do it. Your parents will do it. Your teachers will do it. judgmental. I'm not a "Chrishian." I don't have a heaven to put you in or a hell to send you to. I see you as a person. I have children who are grown now who were once your age, and when I look at you I can see my children, and I want for you what I And I didn't want my children to wanted for my children. confront an adult who's going to make them feel worthless after that adult talked to them, so I'm not going to do it to you. That's the difference between me and you all. You all posture on this floor, but your life does not reflect it. Oh, I'm going to get even, brothers and sisters. What did Kennedy say his daddy told him? Don't get mad; get even. And one of his boys became President of the United States. Now, we know for a black man that's out of the question, but maybe I can be president of the Legislature. Thank you, Mr. President.
