SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Clerk, we now go to LB 75 on Select
File.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 75 on Select File has been considered.
On February 28, the Enrollment and Review amendments were
adopted. When the Legislature left the issue that day, Senator
Chambers had pending FA422. (Legislative Journal page 609.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, being as that was pending,
Senator Chambers, why don't you give us a brief review of the
pending FA422.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Mr. President, members of the
Legislature, this is the beginning shot from me on the rest of
the session. And what this amendment that is offered to Senator
Beutler's proposed constitutional amendment, would be designed
to remove a city of the metropolitan class from the application
of Senator Beutler's amendment. And since Omaha is the only
metropolitan class city, that is what the amendment would be
addressed to--Omaha. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. You've heard
the update on FA422. Open for discussion. Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Cudaback, members of the Legislature,
just to remind you that those who are interested in the bill
oppose the amendment. I think the city of Omaha generally
supports the bill as it is and would encourage you to do the
same. Thank you.
