SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All members report to the Chamber. Unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Senator Chambers, you are closing on your amendment...motion.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: All I will say is that Senator Beutler and I have reached an accord. The reconsideration motion, we're hoping, will be adopted. Then my amendment would be accepted. The bill will move to Final Reading. Senator Beutler and I are going to continue discussing, and he is going to conversations with others. If my mind were rock-solid on opposing his bill no matter what, I would not say that I'm willing to listen to him argue further. If I knew right this moment that nothing he said could change my mind, I would not go along with something like this. As I stated earlier, I'm not toying with him. And that's what I would be doing if, no matter what he said, I would hold to the position that I'm in now. But I'm not ready at this moment to alter my position. This gives us both some breathing time and the opportunity to see what we can work our way through on this bill. That's where things stand. And after the members get here, I will accept a machine vote.
