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would never ever carry a concealed weapon because if I were to use it, if I were to be put in a fearful situation, I might use it and that could be devastating to me. I respect those persons' judgment and I urge you to respect it also. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Kruse. On with discussion. Senator Preister.

SENATOR PREISTER: Thank you, Honorable President. I would yield my time to Senator Chambers, if he would like it.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, you have about 5 minutes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, Annie, Annie Oakley, Belle Starr, Calamity Jane, when your parents call you by all of your names, then you know you're in trouble. Or if I just said "ABC," everything is all right. Senator Combs did not pay attention to the exchange between me and Senator Preister when we covered the territory of military training with firearms, how you are to treat every weapon as though it is loaded, you don't point it at anybody, and no weapons just go off. But the ones who are saying that is a person included in that number who'd be carrying a gun under Senator Combs' bill. He was a law-abiding citizen, Senator Combs, a patriot. He had been in the military. And he stuck the gun in a car window at the occupants because he wanted to make them show respect, as he said. So he killed a man and said he didn't know the gun was loaded and it went off. Senator Louden said something about crime rates in Omaha and in people's district. I'm sure he must have been taking a backhand swipe at me. I didn't hear everything he said. But if he lived and had a chance to see how I operate, he would know better than to make foolish, ignorant, ill-advised statements. I am the one who has spoken on this floor, has gone to the FBI about the number of guns that proliferate in my community. I haven't heard Senator Louden say, Senator Chambers, I'll join you in talking to the FBI and the police chief in Omaha to do something about those illegal guns coming on. Senator Louden didn't say anything about that. He doesn't know that I do a weekly television program and that not only do I tell people we cannot tolerate the shootings and if you know somebody who did a shooting tell
