and America's troops are spread so thin now, even the Pentagon is talking about the danger to this country, and how they cannot be going into other spots in the world where there are problems, if any substantial deployment of American troops must be made. What about what's happening in North Korea? And those troops of American vintage in South Korea? And they might have to start pulling some of them out of there to send them to Iraq or Afghanistan. Then you're going to send them into Iran, also? America is fighting the designated enemies of Israel, and Cheney made his threatening remarks when he was speaking before that Israeli political action committee, the one that has all the senators and congressmen terrified in Washington, and they were the ones who sponsored some spying against this country--Israel agents spying on the United States. One of them was named Jonathan Pollard. And the funny argument was made, since, as they say, Is-ry-el, is an ally of the United States, why are you going to treat an Israeli spy like you treat any other spy? Why, you ought to treat him worse! But that's the kind of stuff they argue. That's the kind of stuff they get away with. So the only war which, if a war is alleged to exist, would be one formally declared by the Congress of the United States, and if that state of affairs existed, a person could carry any number of hidden pistols, a number that would exceed the number of pockets that that person had at the time he or she was stopped. That's what this is all about. That's the kind of bill you got. Americans are so terrified and afraid of everything now, everything! Scared to death! I can just see Osama bin Laden smiling like a Cheshire cat. American against American, "Repelican" against "Repelican," civil rights taken, rights to privacy, rights not to have the business you conduct with the library or bookstore plundered by the government. Your phones tapped without your knowing it. Bin Laden says I did not have the wherewithal to do that within the United States, but I'm whipping them from thousands of miles away. I have impressed into my service the United States government, the President of the United States, Congress, the Justice Department, and the U.S. Attorney General. They're the ones depriving Americans of their right. I should make that plural, their rights, their liberties. American officials have these Americans living in terror every day; got people in little towns where somebody 50 miles away does not know the town exists, scared about
