cities to prohibit carrying concealed weapons. That amendment is not going to be dealt with. And here are some of the other things that are not going to be in that bill. These are the places where these concealed guns can be carried: childcare centers, domestic violence victim or sexual assault victim shelters, residence of another person without his or her permission, playgrounds and parks. And you all and others are so worried about these sex offenders being near parks and playgrounds? Well, without Senator Mines' amendment, these pistol-packing idiots can be actually on these playgrounds and parks. A public swimming pool; now, you might wonder, how is somebody going to carry a concealed weapon in a public swimming pool? Well, they can be on the premises. But Senator Brown reminded me yesterday of some interesting information revealed by former Senator Tyson, whom I referred to as "Baron" Tyson, and I do miss him. Senator Tyson pointed out to Senator Brown that there are holsters, they call them bra holsters, so a person could be attired for swimming but still be carrying a concealed weapon. And if you look at my overall amendment, you will see that various types of outer and undergarments can be used for concealing weapons. I did not think to put swimming trunks, but men can wear some baggy swimming trunks and conceal a pistol therein. In addition to these places, a public recreation facility, a youth center. Why would you want people being authorized to carry concealed weapons at a youth center. At the airport. At the airport. Under Nebraska law, a person can carry a concealed weapon at the airport. If a person is at the airport but is not attempting to board an airplane, I don't know that there is any prohibition against that person being there. But an argument could be made that under the law of this state, simply being on the premises with a concealed weapon is not against the law, and since there was no intent and no effort made to board an aircraft, this person is scot-free. In addition to the airport, a music concert. And you all have been made aware, at least tangentially, of these huge sell-out concerts that are occurring in Omaha...
