SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the motion to advance LB 454A to E & R for engrossing. Open for discussion. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. I would like to ask Senator Combs a question or two about LB 454A.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Combs, would you respond?

SENATOR COMBS: Yes, I will.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Combs, what is in LB 454A at this time?

SENATOR COMBS: LB 454A tells where the money is going to go. It's hereby appropriated money from the Public Safety Cash Fund to the Nebraska State Patrol to aid out in carrying the provisions of LB 454. So essentially...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And...oh.

SENATOR COMBS: ...what it does is it takes the...appropriates where the money that's coming in for the fees are going to go. That's my understanding.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And how much money is expected to come in?

SENATOR COMBS: I know...I don't have the fiscal note in front of me right here. I could pull it up on the gadget. If you want the correct answer, I think probably on your gadget if you get the fiscal note, you'll have the latest one there. It's \$2 million, or close to \$3 million. Is that right?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And the figure is not the main thing I'm going after. I wanted some kind of figure. Now, where is that money supposed to come from? How will it be generated?

SENATOR COMBS: From the \$100 fees that people will pay to get a concealed permit fee (sic).

SENATOR CHAMBERS: You mean permit? They pay that to get a
