SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Combs, would you respond to a question from Senator Chambers?

SENATOR COMBS: If I can answer it, I will.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Combs, LB 454 is your bill, correct?

SENATOR COMBS: That is correct.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And you were complaining yesterday about the World-Herald editor having called you about an editorial that was to be done, and that person had not read your bill. Is that correct?

SENATOR COMBS: That is already on the record. That's correct.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. Now have you had enough time to check your bill to see what a person must do to renew a permit?

SENATOR COMBS: That's what I'm doing right now. I got interrupted by some...two other questions here on the side.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But you don't just know. You're not familiar enough with your bill to answer that question. Is that correct?

SENATOR COMBS: Well, the bill is a lot of pages long, Senator Chambers, and to pick out one specific piece of information out of it, because of the amendment and the other things we've done to it, I've got to make sure that I'm answering it correctly, since it is on the record.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, we haven't amended that part of your bill. I will give you time to continue looking. I'd like to ask Senator Kopplin a bill...a question.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Kopplin, would you yield to a question?
