SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Kopplin, you voted for this bill. Is that correct?

SENATOR KOPPLIN: I did not vote for the bill.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: All right, then I won't ask you this question. Thank you. I'd like to ask Senator Flood a question.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Flood, would you yield to a question from Senator Chambers?

SENATOR FLOOD: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Flood, did you vote for this bill?

SENATOR FLOOD: Yes, I did.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Did you know that under this bill a concealed weapon could be carried at a child...on the premises of a childcare center?

SENATOR FLOOD: I would have to take you at your word for that. I haven't specifically looked at that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'm asking, are you aware?

SENATOR FLOOD: No, I'm not.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. If it could be, would that be troubling to you?

SENATOR FLOOD: If a concealed weapon could be carried into a licensed childcare center?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes. Either it would or it wouldn't.

SENATOR FLOOD: Honestly, yes. Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Would it trouble you if one of these weapons could be carried into a mental health facility?
