SENATOR FLOOD: Well, I know that state law prohibits any weaponry on a...a weapon on a state institution.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Are there other healthcare facilities that are not state run?

SENATOR FLOOD: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Would it trouble you that concealed weapons could be carried into such a healthcare facility?

SENATOR FLOOD: Are you talking like a community-based outpatient center?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Any healthcare facility, any one that you can envision. Thank you, Senator Flood. I will ask you the next question.

SENATOR FLOOD: Okay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Would it bother you that a concealed weapon can be carried into a youth center? That's okay, I won't ask you any more questions. Thank you. Members of the Legislature, this shows what we're dealing with here. Senator Flood cannot answer questions which I know he has the answer to because I've sat with him on the Judiciary Committee and I've heard statements he has made about some of these issues. If there are senators who will stand on this floor and say that they feel comfortable with somebody carrying a concealed weapon into a childcare center, I will say that person is a liar. If one says he or she believes that a person should be able to carry a concealed weapon into a domestic violence victim or sexual assault victim shelter, I would say that person is lying. This is what they voted to allow. They didn't read Senator Combs' bill. They don't know what's in it any more than she knows what's in it. But they voted for it because the NRA put the bullwhip to them. But I will have the opportunity to show the NRA what they have done to this Legislature. I see Senator Combs now appearing as if she has the answer. I'd like to ask Senator Combs a question, Mr. President.
