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FLOOR DEBATE

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SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Combs, will you yield?

SENATOR COMBS: Yes. The answer is, no. If you've not done anything in the previous five years, which 6.5 million permitholders, generally, if you ask about being comfortable,...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: What...are you...

SENATOR COMBS: ...I would be comfortable.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: When a permitholder obtains this permit, it lasts for five years. My question to you was this. When that permit expires, what must a person do to renew the permit? Are you saying it doesn't have to be renewed?
