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A bill. Senator Combs, I'd like to ask you another question.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Combs. I'm sorry, Senator Chambers, your time is up.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Combs, you have the right to respond to the indefinitely postpone motion. You're recognized.

SENATOR COMBS: Well, I really don't want to IPP this bill. I can say that. I don't want to IPP it. But I will continue the discussion. They're just required, subject to--and I will finish answering his question there--in the renewal period, it says, subject to continuing compliance with the requirements of Section 7 of this act. So I would imagine--and I'm not a lawyer--but that the State Patrol could do...take action to make sure that they are continuing compliance. But that's what it says: subject to. That's the only way the permit will be issued, subject to continuing compliance with the requirements of the act. And that's the reason I had my light on. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Combs. Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, thank you, Mr. President and members. In visiting with a few people on the floor, I think there's a little bit of confusion regarding this A bill. And, Senator Combs, I want to clarify for everybody what the cost of this bill is going to be. So if I could...if you've got your A bill up there on your gadget, if I could ask you just a couple of questions?

SENATOR COMBS: Okay.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Combs, would you respond?

SENATOR COMBS: Yes, I will.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you. I think there's an impression here that there aren't going to be any General Funds that are going
