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wound up with that which she did not want. That is a possible interpretation that can be given to the story if we carry it beyond what was told to us, right?

SENATOR FRIEND: Yeah, I think you can come...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: That's possible?

SENATOR FRIEND: I think you can come up with all kinds of assumptions.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Scenarios.

SENATOR FRIEND: Scenarios, yeah.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Now I said all that to bring us back to this bill. We have four bills before us. You are Solomon. You are going to have to make a decision. Which of the four is least important, in your view?

SENATOR FRIEND: Well, I saw the direction that you were going here and I didn't have time to actually, I think, make a value judgment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Then I won't...

SENATOR FRIEND: I would like to maybe go, you know,...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR FRIEND: ...take a little time to go further into that question.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SENATOR FRIEND: What I would...what I would say really from a cursory standpoint is that I think that they are whole now.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: They are what?

SENATOR FRIEND: And...they...this...these provisions are whole
