SENATOR FRIEND: I wouldn't call...I don't know I'd call it suffering, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, but you were present. And if suffering was what would have happened, you would have suffered along with everybody else who was here. Is that true?

SENATOR FRIEND: I was here.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. You know where Senator Combs sits, don't you? You know where her seat is, don't you?

SENATOR FRIEND: Yeah. (Laugh) Yes, I do.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Now, unless she's the invisible woman, who is sitting in Senator Combs' seat right now?

SENATOR FRIEND: In the seat? No one.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Uh-huh. And what does that tell you, if anything?

SENATOR FRIEND: (Laugh) I don't know. I don't know how to answer that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, yes, you do. If it doesn't tell you anything, you say (inaudible).

SENATOR FRIEND: It doesn't tell me anything really. I...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Does it tell you that she's not here?

SENATOR FRIEND: It tells me that she's not here. Thank you.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And you knew that without me telling you, didn't you? You just don't think these things through because you think it's going to lead you someplace you don't want to go.

SENATOR FRIEND: You rarely fluster me, but within about the last 20 seconds you have.
