SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. You've heard the closing on FA552. There's been a request for a call of the house. All in favor of the house going under call vote aye; those opposed, nay. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Unexcused senators report to the Chamber. The house is under call. Unexcused senators please report to the Chamber and record your presence. Senator Dwite Pedersen, Senator Cunningham, Senator Combs. Senators Cornett, Langemeier. Senator Don Pederson, Senator Engel, Senator Brashear. Senators Schrock, Landis, Synowiecki, and Foley. Senator Cunningham, Senator Langemeier, Senator...Cornett is here. Senator Engel. Senator Brashear and Senator Synowiecki. Senator Chambers, I did not hear you?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: (Microphone malfunction)...ceed.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The question before the body is, shall FA552 be adopted to committee amendments, AM2533? All in favor vote aye; opposed, nay. Have you all voted who care to? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 39 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The Chambers amendment has been adopted, and I do raise the call. Mr. Clerk, items for the record, please, or announcements.

CLERK: Mr. President, Business and Labor Committee, chaired by Senator Cunningham, reports LB 354 to General File. New A bill. (Read LB 1086A by title for the first time.) LR 304, a new resolution offered by Senator Cornett; that will be laid over. And a series of amendments to be printed: Senator Burling to LB 915; Senator Chambers to LB 990; Senator Aguilar to LB 915;
