SENATOR CUDABACK: Time, Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: ...of an offer to you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schimek. Further discussion? Senator Brown. Is Senator Brown on the floor. I do not see Senator Brown. Senator Chambers. Senator Chambers waives his opportunity. There are no further lights on. Senator Chambers, you're recognized to close on FA553.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, Senator Schimek has expressed approval of this amendment, and I don't want to take a lot of time on every amendment just to take time, but I feel an obligation, since we're dealing with recall as a system, to explain the amendments that I offer, and having done that, I will simply take the vote now. And before asking for a call of the house, I will see if enough people are here on a machine vote. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the closing on FA553. The question before the body is, shall that amendment be adopted to the committee amendments to LB 786? All in favor vote aye; opposed vote nay. Have you all voted on the Chambers amendment who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.
