CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill at this time, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you. First vote will be to suspend the at-large reading. All in favor vote aye; opposed vote nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 40 ayes, 1 may, Mr. President, to dispense with the at-large reading.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The at-large reading is dispensed with. Mr. Clerk, please read the title of LB 508.

CLERK: (Read title of LB 508.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 508 pass? All in favor vote aye; opposed vote nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 1007-1008.) 43 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 5 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 508 passes. We now go to LB 663E. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers would move to return the bill for specific amendment, that amendment being to strike the enacting clause.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, you're recognized to open on your motion.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, Senators Cudaback and Baker had worked with me on this bill, had taken care of all of the concerns that I have with it. I'm going to support the bill in its present form, and I withdraw that motion.
