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if you will.

SENATOR BYARS: What I don't want to do is to chill the effect of being able to have that relative having to go to a tremendous additional expense, raising the caps above what the rest of us would carry...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time, Senator.

SENATOR BYARS: ...for normal liability.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Further discussion? Senator...I'm sorry, your light just went off. Senator Louden.

SENATOR LOUDEN: Thank you, Mr. President. Members of the body, I guess I would like to ask Senator Byars a question, if he would yield, please.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Byars, would you yield?

SENATOR BYARS: Yes, I will.

SENATOR LOUDEN: Who pays for the mileage? I mean, what fund does it come out of, the Health and Human Services' or...?

SENATOR BYARS: Yes, as I explained on the opening, Senator, the General Fund pays part of it, and part of it is matching federal funds, Medicaid funds.

SENATOR LOUDEN: I see. On these Handi-Buses, which we have in western Nebraska that travel a great distance for some of the people in smaller towns, are they funded out of the same fund, or is that a separate fund?

SENATOR BYARS: It would depend on what they're qualified to receive. It could be. I'm not sure what they...they have to be a qualified individual that's receiving services from the Department of Health and Human Services under Medicaid Title XX, adult and child protective services, emergency assistance, family support. They have to be qualified under a
