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discussion of the Beutler amendment. Seeing no further lights, Senator Beutler, to close on his amendment.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Schimek, members of the Legislature, just to remind you what the amendment is, it drops out the intent to fund language in the main bill, which simply is unnecessary because there is an A bill, and the appropriate mechanisms for dealing with this are not through the main bill but through the A bill. So this amendment eliminates the intent language to no damage to the bill. Thank you.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. You've heard the closing on FA551. The question is the adoption of the Beutler amendment. All in favor vote aye; all opposed, nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted who wish to vote? Record, Mr. Clerk.
