the subdivision to act in that way. People don't even care about the principles behind this amendment that Senator Beutler has added to this bill. That's why I'm not talking about all that. Nobody is going to be informed, because nobody cares. What they care about is whether Senator Beutler is going to whip me. That's what they're interested in, and they will sic Senator Beutler on me, which I personally don't mind. I don't take offense. I admire the youngster's spunk. I admire his get-up, and he's doing what he thinks is right. What I would remind Senator Friend is that they have devices in Iraq -- they're called improvised explosive devices, IEDs. And they're placed along roadsides, and those who are unsuspecting will drive a vehicle over one of those devices and bad things happen. Senator Beutler has managed to put an IED in your bill, and you're going along with the program, because you want to help him stand up to me. You're going to stand behind him, and you're going to push him into the buzz saw. That's what you're...look at you, smiling like a Cheshire cat. But it makes me no difference. Whether we take time on this bill or take time on other bills is all the same to me. And as far as what Senator Louden was asking questions about, these people will be authorized to issue citations, and it's not just the fire chief or the head official, they can designate somebody. And it says, after this person has been trained by a certified law enforcement officer.

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: What kind of training? What does that mean? What will they do, Senator Louden, give him a ticket book and say, now where it says name, write the name, where it says date, write the date, and you just fill that out? So if you come upon somebody and you think they did something wrong, you just fill that out and give that person theirs and you take your copy, and take it downtown. There's nothing in here about training, and we know that they're not going to get anything that would qualify, really, for training, especially when some of these so-called certified law officers themselves have not been that well trained. But I'm not going to go into the details of the bill, because my fight and Senator Beutler's fight is on a different field, and we'll continue our struggle there. Thank
