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SENATOR LOUDEN: Okay, with AM7177, and that's where we went from there, then.

SENATOR FRIEND: Yes.

SENATOR LOUDEN: Okay, well, thank you, Senator Friend. Usually that part in Section 6, I think, is probably the part that, as far as the district I represent, probably do us any good out there, because we do work with some mutual fund organizations between organizations that have mutual work between them, especially on your rural fire districts and some of that. rest of this bill, I...this is something else that doesn't make that much difference for what we do out in our part of the area. And I'm quite concerned about the Section 3, I think, that has given some of these other people authority to write the citations, when I don't know if they are really trained to write citations. And I think there's already something somewhere surely in statutes, that when these smaller towns have problems with codes that it's taken care of some way or another. have a little bit of a problem with that, other than the last part of it, the Section 6 is the part that I could support that. After that, I probably will support Senator Chambers' amendment to strike a batch of it. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Clerk, a motion?

CLERK: Senator Chambers would move to recommit the bill to the Urban Affairs Committee, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, to open on your motion to recommit.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President, and I will have reconsideration motions, too. And all those people standing on the sidelines, all those who want to do the plotting and keep their hands clean, the ones who want to throw the rocks and hide their hands, come out in the open like Senator Beutler is doing, and Senator Friend, and show yourself.
