SENATOR CHAMBERS: And the term "Jonah" has always carried that negative connotation. If somebody is a Jonah, or if there's a Jonah on board it means bad luck. Now Senator Beutler is the Jonah as far as your bill. Now what should you do, if you're going to follow the lead of those seafarers? Will you let the ship go down and Jonah's going to drown anyway? You feel that everybody should drown with Jonah; is that true? That's your posture here today, isn't it?

SENATOR FRIEND: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And you think that is responsible; do you?

SENATOR FRIEND: Well, I don't think it's very responsible what those seafarers did to Jonah.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, do you think what you're doing is responsible? Is it the captain's duty...

SENATOR FRIEND: I think it depends. I...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ... to go down with the ship?

SENATOR FRIEND: Sure.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Should the captain take everybody down with him, if there's a way to rescue the others?

SENATOR FRIEND: Yeah, but if there's not enough lifeboats around, everybody is going down.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Now you're willing to take all of these down with you and Senator Beutler...

SENATOR FRIEND: You're saying ...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...in order to put me in my place, right?

SENATOR FRIEND: You're saying FA605 is a lifeboat?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'm telling you...
