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SENATOR BROWN: I...

SENATOR D. PEDERSON: I didn't prepare the goldenrod book, so I don't know.

SENATOR BROWN: Okay, that...maybe that was something that I just was used to, from being aware of the committee.

SENATOR D. PEDERSON: May I interrupt for one moment?

SENATOR BROWN: Yes.

SENATOR D. PEDERSON: What we did on the committee, generally, when you were on the Appropriations Committee, and recently we'd...as we would go through various agency requests, we would see what the Governor has proposed and then what the committee has proposed, and the difference between the two.

SENATOR BROWN: Right.

SENATOR D. PEDERSON: We do that internally, but we didn't include that in this budget book.

SENATOR BROWN: I always thought we had it as a part of the budget book. Well, my calculations would be that the difference is about \$40 million. I'm not exactly sure. And I wondered what things that the Governor just didn't even include, because a lot of times the Governor's budget comes out so much earlier, much earlier than the committee's budget, that there are things that they didn't even know about. Are you...can you...

SENATOR D. PEDERSON: I'll have to refer to the Fiscal Office to get me some information on the differences, but there were a lot of changes between January and later.

SENATOR BROWN: Yeah, yeah.

SENATOR D. PEDERSON: One of them,...

PRESIDENT SHEEHY: One minute.
