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that most of these agencies are agencies that do offer family planning services.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But let me read a sentence that's in this amendment. On page 2, "The department may contract with a provider who provides some but not all of the services." What are...would be included among those services that would not be provided?

SENATOR FOLEY: That...yes, and that refers to the long list of services on the upper portion of page 2, and these services, of course, have been in statute for many, many years. And there may be some healthcare providers, for example, that would do the Pap smears and chlamydia tests, which by the way, that's where most of this money goes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, let me ask you this question, because I don't want my time to run out. Would you be opposed, should your amendment be adopted, to include contraceptive services in that itemization of services to be provided?

SENATOR FOLEY: Well, contraceptive services are already provided under the federal Title X program, where there's no state match required. Nebraska doesn't make...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: No, here's what I'm asking you. Would you be opposed to including contraceptive services in that list, itemized...itemizing...

SENATOR FOLEY: Well, if we were to do that, Senator, we would substantially dilute the amount of money available for the services that are specified in this program.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Foley,...

SENATOR FOLEY: So if we were to add any other service to the list, you're just going to dilute the amount of money that's available.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Foley, thank you. Members of the Legislature, the way this amendment is drafted, it will
