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services out there now for some of the other kinds of diseases. Every Woman Matters Program, which started with just a little dinky program to screen low-income women for breast cancer, has just blossomed into all kinds of screenings and treatments and so forth. It'd be marvelous if we could put some of...some of this into some of those programs, because those are up and running and they're very successful. But I haven't visited with the Health Department about this. I don't know what they would even envision with this. But I'm willing to talk about it if other people are, and I appreciate very much...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time, Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: ...the debate.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schimek. Further discussion? (Visitors introduced.) On with discussion on the motion to reconsider the vote taken on AM2441. Senator Kruse.

SENATOR KRUSE: Thank you, Mr. President and members. I should correct a statement I made earlier. Several have corrected it, in essence, but I need to own up to an error, and certainly want to avoid any confusion that might be in somebody's mind. I said that this amendment would affect present statute, and it does not. I saw a statute reference in there and was reading too quickly, whatever. I don't...I do not make an excuse for it. I simply want to make the correction that Senator Foley is correct when he says this is changing intent language. There is...the rest of my comments, the weight of my comments stand that when we are dealing with intent language within the committee we are always dealing with an appropriation and, therefore, this does not seem to be an appropriate thing for us to do. But I would be concerned, lest anybody be misled, in what our basic task is here, looking at the forest instead of the trees. Our task that we are engaged in right now is to amend last year's budget bill, and amending intent and figures and all the rest of it, but basically we're looking at amending figures and that's what the Governor has proposed and what the committee has reviewed and studied and what we're about. We are amending last year's budget bill. Thank you, Mr. President.
