SENATOR CUDABACK:      Thank you, Senator Pederson. You've heard the opening on the committee amendments to LB 1061.      Open for discussion.      Senator Janssen, your light was on prior to this motion. I do not see Senator Janssen.      Senator Chambers, your light was also on. Did you wish to speak? You may do so.

SENATOR CHAMBERS:      Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I did not expect us to get to this bill this quickly, so I'm going to have to ask Senator Don Pederson some questions, so that he can help me. Senator Pederson, there are several transfers that will take place under this bill. What is the Administrative License Revocation Cash Fund?

SENATOR CUDABACK:      Senator Pederson, would you reply?

SENATOR D. PEDERSON:      Excuse me just a moment, and I'm with you, Senator Chambers, I didn't know this was going to come up this quickly, either, so I'm kind of trying to gather papers here to respond.

SENATOR CHAMBERS:      Well, should we bracket this bill till tomorrow?

SENATOR D. PEDERSON:      I don't know that it will be necessary, unless we have some detailed questions that we can't answer, and I can answer, I think, your question initially, in just a moment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS:      Okay.      And, Mr. President, while he does that, are you going to stop my time from running while he does that? Otherwise, I run out of time and can't ask the questions. No, you don't have to do that. I'm just showing the difficulty that is encountered when some of us want information on a bill that came up quicker than we anticipated. So I may have to offer some amendments, just to have the opportunity to explore the bill. While he's getting that information, I'll never forget Senator Don Wesely being here.
