SENATOR CHAMBERS: So this is a way to get more money into the ALR Cash Fund. Is that true?

SENATOR D. PEDERSON: Cash funds, instead of General Funds, yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So no money...well, where's the money going to come from that goes into the Child Protection Fund, after that money has been transferred out to the ALR Cash Fund?

SENATOR D. PEDERSON: Starting next year, I understand,...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR D. PEDERSON: ...that will all be part of a General Fund appropriation, for child protection only.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But until that appropriation is made from the General Fund, there will be no money in the Child Protection Cash Fund. Is that true?

SENATOR D. PEDERSON: Well, no, they currently have money left in that fund, and that will...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And that's going to be transferred...

SENATOR D. PEDERSON: ... that will stay in that fund.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Isn't that what's going to be transferred to the ALR Cash Fund? Looks like you're as lost as I am. (Laugh)

SENATOR D. PEDERSON: The amount of \$45,912 in the Child Protective Cash Fund is the amount that was left over before. It stayed in that account. It's two years...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And that's going to be...

SENATOR D. PEDERSON: ...actually two years ago.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: That will be transferred over to the ALR Cash Fund?
