SENATOR BOURNE: So any potential appropriations on a particular bill that's making its way through the...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR BOURNE: ...through the process, any member can go and can look at lines 18 through 27 or, excuse me, lines 18 through 28 and see the status of those potential bills.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Those would be the status of the mainline bills, and then down under 38 and...38 through 41, you'll see the total figures for all bills on Final...for all A bills on Final Reading, and for all A bills on Select File.

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay, so as we work our way through the process, all the...

SENATOR BEUTLER: (Inaudible.)

SENATOR BOURNE: ...A bills, the potential spending is reflected there in lines 38 through 41.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Right. And as we spend more, those boxes in line 41 and 39, those boxes will get smaller and smaller, showing less of a positive balance.

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay, and let me ask you this, Senator Beutler. Then we'll, you know, when we have to have the 3 percent in excess...the 3 percent of what we spend in reserves, then is the percent there in line 33 changed...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time, Senator.

SENATOR BOURNE: ...as we make our way through?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yes.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Bourne. Further discussion? Senator Engel.
