SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our acting chaplain today is Senator Ray Janssen. Senator, please.

SENATOR JANSSEN: (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Janssen. Senator Janssen represents the 15th District. I call the forty-fourth day of the Ninety-Ninth Legislature, Second Session, to order. Senators, please check in. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Are there any corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: (Read corrections, Legislative Journal page 1049.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you. Any announcements, reports, or messages?

CLERK: Mr. President, I have no messages, reports, nor announcements at this time.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you. We now go to the first agenda item. General File, 2006 Senator priority bills, the Stuhr division. Mr. Clerk, LB 1086.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 1086 was a bill introduced by Senator Synowiecki. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 13 of this year. At that time, it was referred to the Health and Human Services Committee. The bill is reported to General File. I have no committee amendments. I do have other amendments to the bill, Mr. President.
