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say, the city of Sidney, which has an Octoberfest annually, which has a large delegation from places like Denver that come up, would the intent be something like a media guide or something to those out-of-state communities about this opportunity, or are you looking at...because essentially, we have to target people that don't live here with money, in order for out-of-state residents to come to see our state, or is it an idea that maybe people as they are passing through, we would utilize the different stops that they may make along the way for personal reasons, or whatever, to help them...

SENATOR BAKER: One minute.

SENATOR ERDMAN: ...better understand the opportunities that are available?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator, I didn't put any parameters around it with respect to those particular things. My idea is simply, what's going to work for us, what will work best for us, and let them look at the different projects and ideas that the local communities bring forth, and hopefully work with the ones that show the greatest promise.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Okay. And then the last question we'll have on this time is, the language also talks about site excursions within the state, so there is some specificity. Would an example...we have the second most visited tourist site in the state in my district, with the actual Cabela's store, which is not on a street, if you will. Or are you talking more rural areas, like the Fort Robinsons, the...or, the Mullen, Nebraskas, where there's a pretty good golf course? I mean, are those the types of site excursions you're referring to? Or is it still one of those, leave it open to whatever the creativity of the group is?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Again, leave it open and let the people...
