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me when it came to protecting that fully developed, born human being that we refer to as a child. These are the kind of bills and amendments that pro-lifers should not hesitate, because it would show that they care about children. Senator Foley will say from time to time, I care about children, I tried to do this or that. And what he tried to do was open the way to give money to some of these agencies he likes that are against family planning. We're talking about children here, children at risk. And we're also talking about children having children. When children have children, they think as children, they behave as children, they understand as children, and they need somebody who can give them direction and guidance. Senator Louden really said it well. If you don't know, you cannot do. And Paul the "Imposter" said, how can they know if they don't have a teacher? This is a modest amount. That's why the Scrooges should go for it. Senator Smith would say, if I can't give an eight-course dinner, I'm not going to give the starving person a crust of bread and a glass of milk. It would be better to let him starve than give something. Senator Howard is pragmatic enough to realize that you must obtain what you can when you're dealing with an intractable problem which we know will never command the expenditure of money required to solve it. So you do things incrementally. You do them in stages, phases, step by step, and in the case of what "Lady" Howard is trying to do, inch by painful inch. You have to beg and plead with people, who will have a minister up there all the time, and many of them will end their prayer, in the name of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. And Jesus is the one who said, suffer the little children to come unto me, and forbid them not, for of such is the kingdom of heaven. And when he was talking about children, he said it were better that a millstone were hanged around a man's neck and he be drowned in the sea than that he offend against one of these, my little ones.
