SENATOR JANSSEN: I'll waive.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Landis, your light is not on.

SENATOR LANDIS: I'm closing. I'm the only light. There is no light. Isn't that right?

SENATOR CUDABACK: You're recognized to close.

SENATOR LANDIS: Good. Okay. Look, we're going to be on this for hours. There will be plenty of chances, once we get this amendment, to apply whatever we want to do here. But these are the terms, which we've explained. This is an amendment to the committee amendment, subject to later adoption. But this is the form in which we want to put before you the construction sales tax exemption, if you will, or to undo the construction sales tax. We clump these ideas up, we put it in this form, and we will be...we'll have that idea in the shape that it needs to be when we decide to do it or not. I'd ask for the adoption of this amendment to this section of the committee amendments, which themselves are debatable and amendable as time goes on.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator. You've heard the closing on AM2800 to AM2801. All in favor of the motion vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. The question before the body is AM2800, which amends AM2801, the first component of the committee amendments. Have you all voted who care to? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the adoption of the amendment to the committee amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: AM2800 has been adopted. Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment to this component of the committee amendments, Senator Brown, AM2668. (Legislative Journal page 1002.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Brown, to open on your motion.
