SENATOR CONNEALY: I don't know whether it will be that big. I believe it will be something quite smaller than that, but I agree that this amount is what's apropos at this point.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But your \$15 million was really being greedy, wasn't it? Because there was no indication, based on the facts, that \$15 million would be needed this year and \$15 million next year. That is purely and highly speculative. Isn't that true?

SENATOR CONNEALY: I don't know if I'd characterize greed as much as foresight.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: It is highly speculative, though, isn't it, the amount that you proposed?

SENATOR CONNEALY: A lot of things that we do here are speculative on what's going to happen in the future.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: It is highly speculative the amount that you proposed. Is that right or is that wrong?

SENATOR CONNEALY: Yes. Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: It is right?

SENATOR CONNEALY: It is speculation...

SENATOR CONNEALY: ...on what's going to come.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator, is Cargill a large producer of ethanol?

SENATOR CONNEALY: Yes, they are, and they're actually going to expand in the state if their plans come to...

SENATOR CONNEALY: ...fruition (inaudible).
