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SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Senator Stuthman.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Thank you, Mr. President and members of the body. I would like to engage in a little conversation with Senator Wehrbein if he would encounter that.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Stuthman, we did not hear you.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: You did not hear me?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Oh, Senator Wehrbein?

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've got a question?

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Okay. Yes. I didn't hear his response. This portion of it with the 15,000 inhabitants of a county, does that apply to this livestock one also?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: So that, you know, any county that's over 15,000, this would not work in?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Well, that's the intent because it goes into this tier.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: So in other words, my county would be left out in that where the inhabitants about (inaudible).

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Well, if you're over 15,000.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Yeah, we're over 15,000, so. Okay, that's the only question I had. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Stuthman, I'm sorry about that. Senator Chambers, there are no further lights on. You're
