move individuals from an undocumented status to a documented status. Guess what those folks that need that legal service get, is zero relative to that, Senator Flood. Now the question I had was relative to the Commission on Public Advocacy and the Legal Aid Services Fund. What's the court fee dedication to that? And as I'm...been told by the Fiscal Office here in just very short notice that Legal Aid of Nebraska receives \$1.1 million through that court fee. Is that your understanding as well?

SENATOR FLOOD: As I stated earlier, I haven't had a chance to look over the numbers, and you're familiar with my situation. I, too, didn't realize that we were...we were going to do this, this morning. So I'll take some time, I'll find out where their money comes from and I'll be able to respond to you. My light is on, so give me a few minutes.

SENATOR SYNOWIECKI: Okay. I appreciate that, Senator Flood. As I indicated, I, too, did not know that this amendment was up. I do know that Legal Aid of Nebraska does wonderful work. I endorse that. That's not an issue. An issue is, is that we have, I believe,...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR SYNOWIECKI: Excuse me, Senator Cudaback?

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR SYNOWIECKI: Thank you. We have other providers of legal services to the poor that can...that can deliver a scope of services that is much more open than Legal Aid of Nebraska, quite frankly. And that's no fault of Legal Aid of Nebraska, don't get me wrong, but we have to...and I don't know if I'm necessarily against this amendment. I just don't know enough about it. The Legal Aid of Nebraska does receive funding through the Legal Aid Services Fund, and that fund is funded through court fees. And Fiscal Office has informed me that the last go-round on grant making through that Legal Aid and Services Fund, that Legal Aid of Nebraska received in excess of \$1 million.
