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any monies...

SENATOR COMBS: Doesn't, okay.

SENATOR RAIKES: ...out of the Universal Service Fund.

SENATOR COMBS: All right. And one last question. Thank you.

SENATOR RAIKES: Keep streaming in.

SENATOR COMBS: Have the schools been given the opportunity to really exhaust other federal grant programs to implement distance learning before the state of Nebraska takes the burden on their shoulders?

SENATOR RAIKES: Well, certainly any programs available out there would still be available with this program. Because, as I say, school districts are being treated as individual entities, decision makers, in the process so that, as near as I know, there wouldn't...

SENATOR CUDABACK: You may continue, Senator Combs.

SENATOR COMBS: Thank you. Okay. Thank you very much. I appreciate it. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You're welcome. Further discussion? Seeing none, Senator Raikes, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR RAIKES: Thank you, Mr. President. Members, I urge your support of this amendment. Again, it delays a change that I think will make the transition easier for a number of school districts in the state, and does a technical correction. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Raikes. You've heard the closing on AM2854 to LB 1208. The question before the body is, shall that amendment be adopted? All in favor vote aye; opposed, nay. Question before the body is the Raikes amendment, AM2854. Have you all voted who care to? Please record, Mr. Clerk.
