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new ground, so to speak. But the point is to try to, you know, to try to have some documentations, you know, somewhere, whether it be through Health and Human Services or, you know, through our criminal system.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Well, I just was wondering where...

SENATOR STUHR: So...yes.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...I mean, it looks like to me there might have to be a change in reporting forms, because some of this could...

SENATOR STUHR: Right, could slip...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...we already could have it now and don't know it, because it's not reported as such, or...

SENATOR STUHR: Yes. That's very true. And with this legislation, I think, then we, you know, will be able to have something to document.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: From this standpoint, who do you think is in charge here? Do...I mean, we always need someone in charge. Who's going to be...

SENATOR STUHR: Do you mean from the departments, or...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Well, yeah. I mean, where is the focal point going to be on...where are they going to get their data from? I just wonder if there's something here that needs to be indicated.

SENATOR STUHR: More precise.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: We have a nice window here to look at each other, at least. Right? (Laugh)

SENATOR STUHR: Right. (Laugh) Okay. Well, if, you know, if there...if you see some way that we could improve it, I'm certainly, you know, open to, you know, to that suggestion. We
